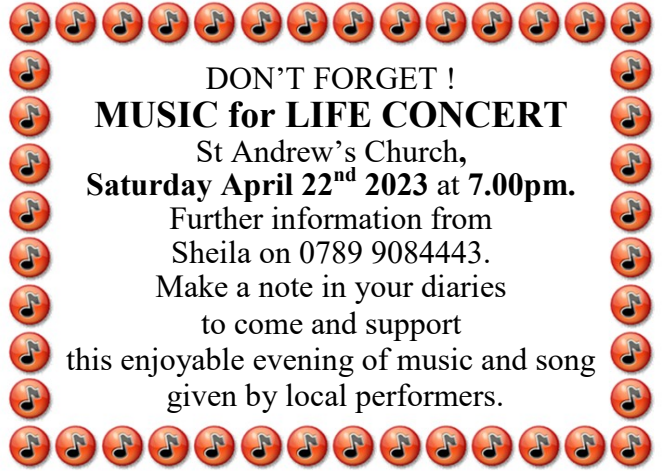

## EAKRING PARISH COUNCIL

To celebrate Florrie Kent's 100<sup>th</sup> birthday the Parish Council have planted a pear tree in the Community Orchard on School Lane.

The Parish council have been informed by the Highways Department that residents on Triumph Road and Triumph Close have complained about potentially illegal parking on the junction of the two roads. The Highways Department is considering appropriate methods to prevent this potential safety issue.

Recently there have been reports of inappropriate speeding on Back Lane. Speeding appears to be an unfortunate regular occurrence within the village and the Parish Council are looking to work with SpeedWatch to start traffic monitoring.

Apparently N & S DC are considering introducing glass collection as part of their rubbish recycling services. As glass is collected in Eakring (and other locations) by ROB, the Parish Council sees this as a possible waste of money and resources. We are awaiting clarification from the council.

The next Parish Council meeting will be held on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> April** commencing at **7.30pm** in the Cator Hall, everyone is welcome.
