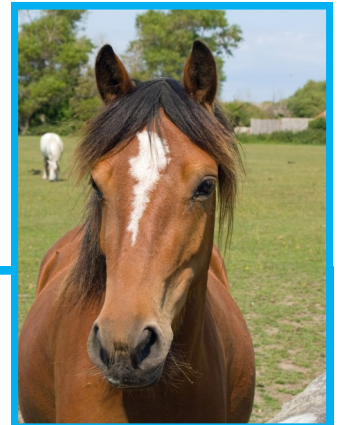

Thank you so much for your precious gift of £310.00, which is helping us to transform the lives of hungry children around the world with a nutritious daily meal in school.

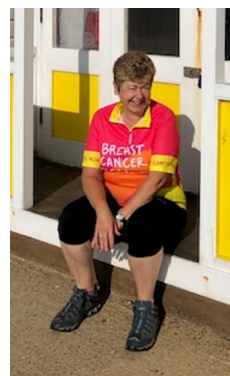
