EAKRING PARISH COUNCIL

A number of villagers have contacted the Parish Council about inconsiderate car parking on pavements around the village. Whilst the Parish Council understands that people do this to minimise disruption to road users, they should also consider pedestrians who may have pushchairs, small children or dogs. Parking on a pavement is an offence. On a similar theme, a discussion took place at this month's Parish Council about people placing items and planting shrubs etc. on the verges in front of their properties. Again the Parish Council understand why this is done, to protect the verge from being spoilt by parked cars, however in many cases the verge is owned by the County Council who may insist that any items are removed.

This year the Parish Council want to undertake extensive refurbishment work at the Cator Hall, this includes replacing internal fire doors; replastering and painting internal walls; replacing external fencing; and repairing and painting the external rendering. If anyone would like to tender for any of the work or knows of any local companies who may be interested, then please let the Parish council know.

Please note that there will not be a Parish Council meeting in January and the next meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 8th February** commencing at **7.30pm** in the Cator Hall, All are welcome.
