CHARNWOOD HOUSE - EAKRING

Creative Care (East Midlands) Ltd who own Sternhill Paddock have recently acquired Charnwood House which we will be opening as another care home next door to Sternhill Paddock. I apologise for any inconvenience whilst the building work is being undertaken to improve the home. We are converting the home for four residents to live in their own selfcontained living space to give them greater independence. Many will know the company has 10 homes throughout Nottinghamshire for adults with Autism, Learning disabilities and complex needs including mental health. Charnwood will be no different, other than the residents will be all male adults living in the home and will have a dual diagnosis of mental health and learning disability. These residents are placed to live here by the Nottinghamshire County Council and we look forward to welcoming them into the community. The home is due to be finished in July and it will then be registered by the Care Quality Commission who regulates all care homes. The home will have its own CQC registered home manager and we would be happy for anyone in the village to arrange to visit if they are interested.


