EAKRING PARISH COUNCIL

The Eakring Parish Council AGM was held in May. Cllr Richard Ford was re-elected as Chairman and Cllr Robert Brown as Vice-Chairman.

The Parish Council are continuing to liaise closely with County Councillor Scott Carlton to try to address some of the issues in the village relating to pot holes, blocked gullies and over-hanging hedges. It is pleasing to see that some of the pot holes have been filled in and some gullies cleared. White line painting is scheduled to be undertaken shortly. The condition of the road to Kirklington, near to the National Grid Academy, is still causing concern and we are trying to resolve this.

Work continues on the improvements to the Cator Hall. Plans relating to the kitchen, the fire alarm system, the internal fire doors and the patio gates are all progressing. Recently a new front door, a new rear kitchen door and a new kitchen window have been fitted and the outside lighting upgraded.
