The Annual Parish Meeting, the Annual Parish Council Meeting and the monthly Parish Council Meeting will be held in the Cator Hall on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022 starting at 7.30pm, everyone is welcome. If anyone representing a local organisation would like to attend the Annual Parish Meeting or provide a written note relating to their activities over the past twelve months, it would be appreciated.

The Parish Council have been liaising with the County Council relating concerns regarding the state of various drains, gullies, verges and roads in and around the village. It is hoped that this will lead to any necessary actions being taken to undertake essential repairs. A particular concern relates to the state of Back Lane near the junction with Side Lane, which has been raised by several residents. However, we have been informed that a Highways Inspector has visited Back Lane but "at this time no actionable safety defects are present and that we will of course continue to monitor the surface condition during our regular routine inspections in the area".

The plans for the Queen's Jubilee Weekend have been finalised and a leaflet has been delivered to every house in the village. The leaflet has details of how you can register your interest to participate in some of the events, so please do so in order that the organisers will have an idea of the numbers of people will be participating.
