Contractors have repaired the entrance door. Replacement window panels are being manufactured and a Councillor is planning to fit them free of charge. Local volunteers have been busy brightening up the area with flowers and general maintenance.

Acoustic panels are to be fitted to the ceilings in the Main Hall and Oakring Room, this will improve acoustics and reduce echo. The kitchen ceiling will be completed, followed by total interior re-decoration of the entire Hall in the forthcoming weeks.

With much appreciated help from Marie Worley, the old records have been sorted and are being put in good order for the future.


