New rules make it a legal requirement for everyone in Great Britain who keeps birds to register with the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA), regardless of the size of their flock, even if the birds are kept as pets. Keepers must register before 1 October 2024. Register as a keeper of less than 50 birds on GOV.UK www.gov.uk/guidance/register-as-a-keeper-of-
