Next meeting is Wed. December 11th and we look forward to seeing as many people there as possible.

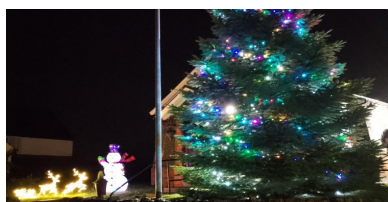

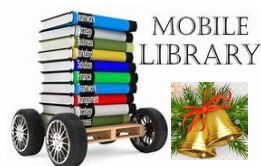
EAKRING CANCER SUPPORT GROUP
