New Eakring Woodland Planted



The late February sunshine helped 55 local people enjoy planting 3,000 trees in a new wood on the edge of Eakring. The land, trees, guards and posts were provided by Chris Parsons and Eakring Farming Ltd, the digging, planting and post hammering was done by Eakring Farming staff and 55 volunteers.

Some people came for an hour or so, some for half a day and some for several days. One very small volunteer just planted one tree but did it with style and mud pies. The trees are a mix of Oak, Sweet Chestnut, Lime, Hornbeam, Birch, Hazel and other native species. In appreciation of our work Eakring Farming have donated **£4,550** to good causes chosen by volunteers: Alzheimer's Society, Eakring Cancer Support Group, Mind Nottinghamshire, Woodland Heritage, Cancer Research and Home Start Newark.
