The 'Not the London Marathon' took place on Sunday 27th April. It is an event run from Chapel House, Church Lane. Flags are put up round the footpaths of Eakring totalling 26.2 miles. There are four loops so people can walk/run anything from 4 miles to the full marathon distance. People come back to the house between each loop for coffee and cake. A total of 49 people took part, with many completing the full marathon in the sunshine.

We raised an amazing **£1725** for the Kapporet Trust, which raises money for an orphanage in India. All the proceeds go to the charity from the family run event. 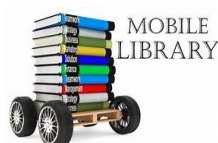
The Council have now appointed a permanent clerk, who will join us at the next Parish Council meeting on June 11th at 7.30pm at the Cator Hall.

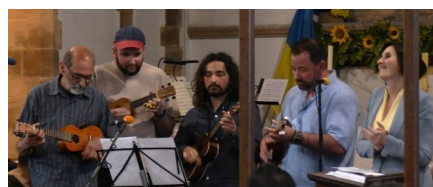
CONGRATULATIONS

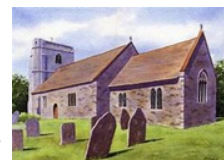
