EAKRING WOMEN'S INSTITUTE

The president welcomed Janice Rose of Janice Rose lingerie who gave us a very informative talk about the importance of wearing a good fitting bra.

She explained why most women wear bras that don't fit correctly, that different manufacturers fit differently, meaning that you are not just one size.

She then explained in detail breast health. Janice then touched on the failings of hospital cancer services where nurses are not trained in how to fit bras or have extensive prosthesis to fit patients and enhance their appearance. She went onto give us details of her bra bank where she recycles bras in aid of Against Breast Cancer and sends them to Africa where having underwear helps protect women from rape and abuse.

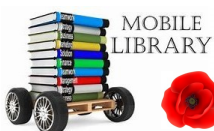

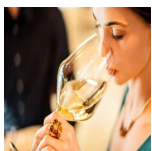
