At our last evening, we started with some excellent
white and rose Graham Beck South African fizz,
which at around £16 a bottle would give many
French champagnes a run for their money any day.

Also tasted were classic wines from well-known
regions including Chablis, Chateaufort du Pape and
La Rioja. Each of these wines were blind tasted with
a comparable wine from just outside the stated
region. Also, blind tasted for comparison were a
new-world and an old-world Sauvignon Blanc. The
blind tasting showed that even those who think they
know a wine when they taste one can be caught out!
